### Reporting Litterers

*Who do I report to?*

In New South Wales, an Enforcement Officer must witness an offence for a fine to be issued. However public reports are taken seriously and litterers may be issued with a warning letter.

*What information do I need?*

The vehicle:

- registration number
- make & model
- colour & type

When and where:

- street, suburb, nearest cross street
- date and time

Description of the person (if possible)

- including whether or not they were the driver or the passenger

*What information about myself must I provide?*

- name
- address
- phone number
